- An approved Capital Improvement Project will enable the district to address a wide range of identified needs.
- Just like a private residence, the Capital Improvement Project would preserve and protect the community's investment in the school district facilities.
- Items identified in the Capital Improvement Project are too costly to address through the Annual Budget.
- The Capital Improvement Project utilizes State Aid and EXCEL Aid to lower overall costs to taxpayers.
- If approved, the cost would be spread out over 15 years.

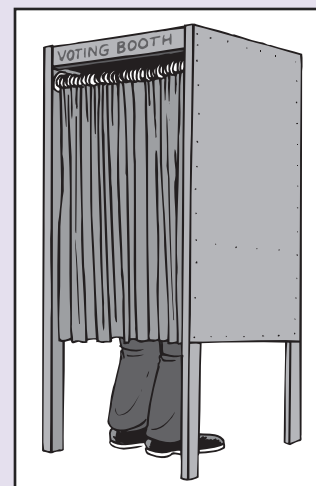
